

July 28, 2022 Special Meeting Minutes

The Castlewood City Council met on the above date at 6:00 pm for a special meeting with the following members present: Mayor Brian Ries, Jeanette Bohls, Heather Schmit, Chad Ries, Stef Goldhorn, and LeeAnne Dufek. Also present: Alisha Nielsen and Lois Wiarda.

The meeting was called to order by the mayor. The agenda was presented with the addition of staffing update by Mayor Ries. A motion to approve was made by Schmit and seconded by C. Ries All members present voting aye and the motion passed.

The pledge of allegiance was led by the mayor.

A moving permit was received from Austin Tvedt to move a new utility shed in his back yard to replace one that was damaged in the storm. A motion to approve this permit was made by Dufek and seconded by Schmit. All members present voting aye and the motion passed.

A moving permit was also presented by the school to move in a mobile classroom and kitchen. A motion to approve the permit was made by Bohls and seconded by Schmit. All members present voting aye and the motion passed.

Lois Wiarda representing the Castlewood Community Foundation was present asking the city if there were any needs not covered by insurance that the Foundation may help with. After some discussion, council members were asked to think about this, and it will be discussed at the August 4th meeting.

First Premier Bank Resolution: Mayor Ries asked the council to approve the signing of this resolution. It basically clarifies what banking functions Mayor Ries, Cassidy Borer and Bohls are approved to authorize. Motion to approve the resolution was made by Goldhorn with a second from C. Ries. All members present voting aye and the motion passed.

Mayor Ries also told the council that Borer will be returning to work on August 8th working 20hrs per week in the office for 4 weeks. She will be back full-time on September 6th. Deb will continue to work on a part time basis until further notice.

Motion to adjourn made by Dufek with a second by Goldhorn. All members present voting aye and the motion passed.
