

Castlewood City Council
January 20, 2021

The Castlewood City Council met in special session on the above date at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Jeanette Bohls, Heather Schmit, Jenny Olson, Jeff Shepherd, Mayor Brian Ries, Michelle Barker and Chad Ries. Also present: Sheila Gerhold.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ries.

The agenda was presented and approved on a motion by Schmit and seconded by Olson with all members present in favor and motion passed.

The transfer of the Ship's Inn on and off sale liquor licenses will be transferred to JBA, LLC Terry and Angela Heyn new owner's of the Ship's Inn. A motion by Bohls and seconded by Barker to approve the transfer and allow Mayor Ries to enter into an operating agreement with the Ship's Inn. All in favor and motion passed.

Mike Thyen requested renting bleachers for his bull sale in February. After some discussion a motion by C. Ries and seconded by Schmit to allow him to use the bleachers with the following stipulations: any damage done to the bleachers will be at Thyen's cost to repair them; A \$125 deposit to ensure they are returned in good condition; if the bleachers are frozen in the ground they will not be able to be used and the council decided instead of rent he could make a donation to the ballfields. All members in favor and motion passed.

The new flood map from FEMA for the City of Castlewood was reviewed. The City has 60 days to suggest any changes they feel are necessary. The flood map is tabled for the regular February meeting.

A motion by Schmit and seconded by Olson to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 7:09 p.m.
