

Castlewood City Council
May 17, 2021

The Castlewood City Council met in special session on the above date at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Heather Schmit, Mayor Brian Ries, Jenny Olson, Michelle Barker, Jeff Shepherd and Jeanette Bohls. Absent: Chad Ries. Also present: Sheila Gerhold.

The meeting was called to order by the mayor.

The agenda was presented for approval. The Recreation Board was added to the agenda. A motion by Olson and seconded by Bohls to approve the agenda with the added item with all members present voting aye and motion passed.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Ries.

No one appeared for public comments.

Ship's Inn requested moving their liquor license to Memorial Park on June 5th and June 6th. They are having a softball tournament. The city is requesting a \$125 deposit to ensure all garbage is picked up and the park is left clean. Ship's Inn is paying for the special meeting. A motion by Barker and seconded by Bohls to approve the liquor license transfer with all members present in favor and motion passed.

Discussion was held on some recreation equipment that needs to be purchased. The bats that the boys use have changed regulations so the 12 and under would like to purchase a \$300 bat. A boys baseball team also needs new catching equipment. Discussion was also held on inventory for equipment. A motion by Bohls and seconded by Olson to approve the purchases of equipment. All in favor and motion passed.

Discussion was held on the recreation committee meetings. Some of the members were not notified of a meeting to hand out equipment because of a time crunch. Discussion was also held on hiring a rec coordinator to organize equipment, line up umpires, etc. A job description will be obtained and presented at the next city council meeting to determine what kind of wage would be paid.

A motion by Olson and seconded by Barker to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
